

ELITe names Toyo as engineering partner for Infinite Loop India facility

Ester Loop Infinite Technologies (ELITe), an India joint venture between Loop Industries and Ester Industries, has awarded the detailed engineering contract for its Infinite Loop India project to Toyo Engineering India.

The award follows completion of design by Tata Consulting Engineers and marks the final engineering phase before construction begins. The scope includes detailed design, procurement engineering and preparation of technical documentation.

The Infinite Loop India facility is being developed to supply recycled PET resin to the packaging and textile sectors. The plant is designed with an annual capacity of 70,000 metric tonnes of PET resin and is planned for completion by the end of 2027.

The joint venture has also signed a multi-year offtake agreement with Nike, which will serve as the anchor customer for the facility.

“Our detailed engineering partnership with Toyo marks a meaningful step forward in delivering India’s first Infinite Loop facility. With the land secured and Nike confirmed as our anchor customer, the project now stands on a strong technical foundation with clear commercial visibility,” said Arvind Singhania, Chairman and CEO of Ester Industries.
